With reference to the subject cited above, I have the honour to inform you that the fourth meeting of Central Advisory Board on disability in Agenda no.- 6 reviewed the position of implementation of provisions of various of PwD Act 1995 and subsequently reservation of 4 percent of posts earmarked in terms of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 as per specified manner of calculation of vacancies, maintaining vacancy based roster meant to be reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities through maintaining vacancies in compliance of section 34.

Also special recruitment drives has to be conducted to fill up vacancies category wise.

In this context, you are requested to submit a report in consolidated form in the following format as available in the department to submit action taken on the Agenda no- 6 for review in the next meeting of Central Advisory Board.

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6. The Central Advisory Board may advise the States/UTs to:
- i. to implement reservation provision in letter and spirit;
 - ii. complete the exercise of identification of posts suitable for various categories of persons with disabilities latest by December, 2020, if not yet, done so;
 - iii. to issue appropriate instructions for implementation of Section 34 of the RPwD Act, 2016;
 - iv. conduct training of the State Government officials of various organisations and sensitizing them about the provisions of reservation for PwDs and the manner of calculation of vacancy, maintaining of roster, etc;
 - v. to issue instructions to all State agencies for filling up backlog of vacancies through special recruitment drive meant for PwDs in terms of PwD Act, 1995 and RPwD Act, 2016;
 - vi. to develop an online mechanism for compilation of data on appointment of persons with disabilities in terms of the provisions of RPwD Act as under:-
